HIFLD History



- The Homeland Infrastructure Foundation-Level Data (HIFLD) Working Group was established in February 2002 to address desired improvements in collection, processing, sharing, and protection of homeland infrastructure geospatial information across multiple levels of government and to develop a common foundation of homeland infrastructure data to be used for visualization and analysis on all classification domains.
- Maintaining this original purpose, the HIFLD Working Group has attracted a voluntary coalition of federal, state, and local government organizations and supporting private industry partners who are involved with geospatial issues related to Homeland Defense (HD), Homeland Security (HLS), Emergency Preparedness and Response (EP&R), or Civil Support (CS).







HSIP Gold 2012

- Compilation of ~450 Vector layers comprised of Commercial, Federal and State level Acquisitions.
- Delivers Common Operational Data to the GEOINT Analyst.



LiDAR

- Acquire unclassified high-resolution 1 meter elevation data over HSIP 133 major urban core areas of the U.S. – 5 year refresh schedule



Imagery

- Acquire unclassified high-resolution ortho-imagery (12 inch GSD or better) over HSIP 133 major urban areas of the U.S. – 2 year refresh schedule

HSIP Gold 2012 Data Licensing

- **HSIP Gold Base Licensing (NGA Funded)**

- *United States Federal Government License*
 - *Canadian Government Partnership License*
 - *Non-Federal Emergency Data Release License*
 - *The designated lead federal agency shall determine which non-Federal agencies receive access to the licensed data under a presidentially declared national emergencies or crisis.*
 - *Derivative products created from the dataset will be releasable to mission partners. Homeland Security is defined as the protection of people, property, and/or resources within the United States and its territories against natural disasters and/or man-made threats and attacks.*

- **HSIP Gold Data Disclosure Non-Emergency (NGA Funded)**

- *Non-Federal government disaster/emergency response agencies and/or personnel supporting the Homeland Security mission to “view” the data via a Federal Government owned, secure (i.e., password protected) system – restricted from downloading the data*

HSIP Freedom 2012

- Available to State and local governments
- 260 layers
- A subset of HSIP Gold; comprised of license-free data
- Access through the DHS Homeland Security Information Network (HSIN) GIS Portal

HSIP Gold 2012 Update

Highlighted Improvements:

- 5 DVD Set – Primarily ArcGIS 9.3 File Geodatabases
- Relative Paths for all ArcGIS Layer Files (.lyr)
- Metadata configured for use in ArcGIS 9.3 and 10
- Continue to strive for more complete FGDC compliant Metadata for all data provided in HSIP Gold 2012.

Highlighted Updated Data Layers:

- State EOCs – Coordinated with NGA PMHR and HTTR IEB's to:
 - Update dynamic links to the Emergency Operations Center or State Emergency Management website
 - Add dynamic links to traffic information via State 511 Intelligent Traffic System (ITS) website
- EPA FRS – Addition of ArcGIS Layer Files for each Program of Interest
- NGA Updated Key public venue layers (i.e. NFL arena's, MLB stadiums, State Capitols, etc... with updated attribution)

Highlighted Updated Data Layers continued:

- National Rail Network (Rails, Tunnels, and Yards)
- Daycare Facilities (completed)
- Education Layers

Highlighted New Data Layers:

- US National Grid

HSIP Gold 2012 Update

NAVTEQ SDC Product:

- 40+ data layers for each of 3 separate area coverages: North American continent, Bahamas/Cayman Islands, LeadDog (subcontractor) islands/territories coverage
- Mexico now integrated into North American coverage
- 8 additional islands in 2012 LeadDog coverage
- Associated .mxd file, routing services, street level geocoding locators

LandScan USA Population Data:

- Utilizes 2010 Census data for the first time
- Total of 9 daytime/nighttime raster data files, covering continental United States, Alaska, Hawaii, & Puerto Rico
- 3 arc-second resolution

LandScan Global Population Data (subset)

- Coverage over North American continent (U.S., Canada, & Mexico)
- Extends out to Hawaii & Caribbean regions
- 30 arc-second resolution



HSIP Gold NAVTEQ Data Licensing

- **HSIP Gold Data Release & Disclosure Non-Emergency (NGA Funded for NAVTEQ Data Release – **renewed for 2012**)**
 - *In support of State Fusion Centers, EOCs, State GIS Coordinators, State National Guard Joint Operation Centers, and State Emergency Management Coordination*
Note: DoD Directive 5105.83 dated 05January 2011 - State National Guard Joint Operation Centers considered federal support
- **Release NAVTEQ Data to States for use in steady daily operations (non-emergency)**
 - *Make HSIP data more readily accessible to State Governments*
 - *Reduce restrictions on HSIP data to use/share geospatial data*
 - *Increase use of common operational data supporting the mission*
 - *Response to HIFLD WG HSIP Gold/Freedom Feedback Session*
- **NAVTEQ Data Distribution**
 - *DVD Distribution – Request from HIFLD web site or HTTR Reps*

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HSIP Gold 2012

HSIP Gold is a unified homeland infrastructure geospatial data inventory assembled by NGA in partnership with the Department of Homeland Security for common use by the Federal Homeland Security and Homeland Defense (HLS/HD) Community. It is a compilation of over 450 geospatial datasets, characterizing domestic infrastructure and base map features, which have been assembled from a variety of Federal agencies and commercial sources.

Due to licensing restrictions, NGA can only disseminate HSIP Gold to those requestors who are validated as Federal Interagency members of the HLS/HD Community (or their supporting National Guard Forces, contractors, and consultants). - Highlights include:
 - **GII Services** – Homeland Security critical infrastructure data services (KML, GeoRSS, REST, SOAP), incident imagery and data, Landscan population
 - **DHS OneView** – Web based viewer access to Homeland Security data, spatial query tools, user added data (KML, GeoRSS), Bing Maps StreetView and Bird's Eye
 - **DHS Earth** – KML network link leverages the GII to visualize data bundles in a Google-ready format to support operation planning, incident response, ect.
 - **Geocoding Services**


